Tasting Notes:

The Stewy ripe fruits coat your front palate and quickly turns to rugged terror with depth. Exploding with flavor, this Zinfandel has a more blooming fruits compared to past vintages, thanks to the long ripening Summer in Paso Robles. Bold, yet restrained, this Zinfandel is easily paired with spicy pastas or Barbecued dishes.

Vineyard Source:

The Dante Dusi Vineyard, planted in 1945, is a head-trained and dry-farmed vineyard, which is an old world style of farming resulting in a low yielding, highly concentrated fruit. Farmed by 5 generations of the Dusi family, this 100 acre vineyard serves as a benchmark to the Paso Robles Wine Industry.
